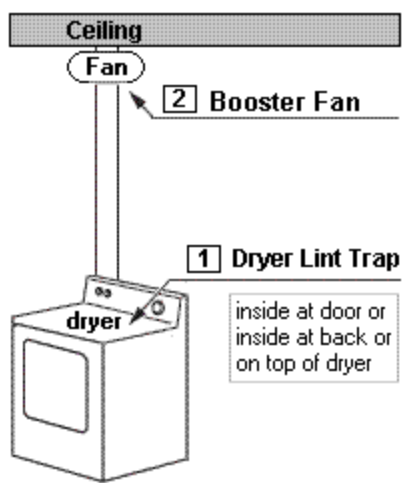


PLEASE FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES TO HELP KEEP WATER OUT OF THE DRYER DUCT



(IF POSSIBLE)

▶ **IMPORTANT**

- **DO NOT DRY LARGE OR MULTIPLE LOADS OF LAUNDRY BACK TO BACK ALL IN ONE DAY**

BECAUSE

- **A SINGLE LOAD OF WASHED LAUNDRY CAN CONTAIN UP TO 1 GALLON OF WATER AND, THE HOT MOISTURE LADEN AIR (PRODUCED FROM DRYING MULTIPLE LOADS OF LAUNDRY "BACK TO BACK - ALL IN ONE DAY") CAN OVERLOAD THE DRYER DUCT SYSTEM AND LEAD TO "CONDENSATION AND WATER POOLING INSIDE THE IN-SLAB DUCT" AND LEAD TO "CEILING LEAKS AND WATER STAINS"**

▶ **DRYER VENT MAINTENANCE**

- **KEEP "DRYER DUCT" AND "EXTERIOR DRYER VENT" IN CLEAN AND CLEAR CONDITION.**
- **HAVE THE "DRYER DUCT AND THE EXTERIOR DRYER VENT" CLEANED AT LEAST ONCE PER YEAR) BY QUALIFIED PERSONNEL, (OR MORE OFTEN DEPENDING ON DRYER USE)**

▶ **CLEANING THE INSIDE OF THE DRYER UNIT**

- **IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT "DRYER LINT" BE REMOVED FROM "INSIDE THE DRYER UNIT" - EVERY 2 YEARS, (OR MORE OFTEN, DEPENDING ON DRYER USE).**

▶ **WARNING NOTE:**

CLEANING "THE INSIDE OF THE DRYER UNIT" SHOULD ONLY BE PERFORMED "BY A QUALIFIED APPLIANCE TECHNICIAN" (because live electrical parts are inside the dryer unit).

▶ **BEFORE STARTING THE DRYER**

1. **CLEAN LINT TRAP - IN DRYER UNIT**

▶ **WHEN DRYER STARTS**

2. **MAKE SURE "DRYER DUCT - BOOSTER FAN" STARTS**

▶ **IMPORTANT**

- **PUT ONLY ONE SMALL LOAD OF CLOTHES IN DRYER (SPIN DRIED CLOTHES - NOT DRIPPING WET)**
- **DRY ONE OR TWO SMALL LOADS OF LAUNDRY / PER DAY (IF POSSIBLE)**
- **DRY ONE LOAD IN MORNING AND ONE LOAD IN EVENING**
